3. East Slavic folklore in the European and world context.
4. Teaching foreign languages and literature in the East Slavic countries.

**The working languages** are Belarusian, Russian, Ukrainian, English, German, and French.

**Form of participation in the conference:** in-person, in-absentia.

**Work schedule: plenary report** – up to 20 minutes; **section report** – up to 10 minutes.

**To participate in the conference**, register on the website **konf.msu.by** through the google form **REGISTRATION** by **October 20, 2021**.

**The e-text of the report** (the sample is attached) and **e-application to the conference** (the sample is attached) are submitted to the organizing committee (**by e-mail**) **until October 20, 2021**. Personal invitations are sent to participants **until October 25, 2021**.

Following the conference, a **collection of scientific articles** will be published (RISC). The Editorial Board reserves the right to select materials for publication.

**Travel, meals and accommodation** for conference participants are paid by sending organizations.

**The organisation fee** for the publication of a collection of scientific articles and the procedure for concluding a contract will be indicated in personal invitations.

**The author is considered to be a participant** in the conference after the text of the scientific article is provided, the organisation fee is paid on time and the contract is concluded. ***In case of refusal to conclude a contract, the article cannot be published, the organisation fee is not refundable.***

**Requirements for submitted articles**

The texts of article (4–6 full A4 pages) should be typed through the text editor Microsoft Word for Windows (the single interval, font – Times New Roman, 14 pt; all margins – 25 mm).

The first line – the UDC index, the second line – Full name of the participant(-s), place of work, city, country, e-mail (in the center). One interval – the title of the article (in the center). One interval – the summary in Russian and English (font 12). The next line contains keywords in Russian and English (font 12). The main text is printed after one interval (paragraph indentation 1.25 cm). References should be put in square brackets. The list of references should be placed at the end of the text.

**Texts of articles, which do not comply with the abovementioned requirements, will not be accepted, the organisation fee is not refundable.**
